Hearing sensitivity bilaterally within normal limits (0-24.db HL);
aided/non-aided and/or speech discrimination within functional
limits for telephone and personal communication
Visual acuity of 20/60 in at least one eye with or without correction
Color perception is a necessity to perform job
Ability to "effectively" communicate the English language,
requiring very good to excellent verbal communication skills
Good written communication skills.
