

The situation surrounding COVID-19 (novel coronavirus) continues to evolve, and changes occur rapidly. As a result, effective Saturday, March 14, 2020, Crozer-Keystone Health System is restricting visitation across all of our facilities.

Visitors will not be permitted in inpatient areas, unless clinically necessary as determined by the health care team. In outpatient areas and maternity units, patients are permitted to have one support person with them. Any approved visitor must pass a risk assessment screening before entry, which includes a series of questions related to travel and respiratory symptoms.

We recognize that interacting with friends and family can be helpful to the healing process, and strongly encourage everyone to utilize other forms of support, such as phone calls, video chats on cell phones, or other mobile devices. We are sensitive to the separation this restriction causes our patients and their loved ones, but we believe this measure of protection is essential at this time to keep people safe.

At Crozer-Keystone, our top priority is the health and safety of our patients, their families, and our team members. We are continuously evaluating all guidelines and procedures and adjusting as needed on a daily basis.
